# **Chocolate Chip Oatmeal** Ingredients:



1 cup Packed light brown sugar

1 cup Granulated sugar

2 Eggs

1 Teaspoon vanilla extract

3 Cups sifted all-purpose flour

1/2 Teaspoon baking soda

1/2 Teaspoon salt

1 Cup quick-cooking oats

2 Cups Semi-Sweet Chocolate Chips

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F lightly grease cookie sheets.
- 2. Beat shortening, both sugars, egg, and vanilla in large bowl on medium with an electric mixer until fluffy.
- 3. Sift together flour, baking soda and salt.
- 4. Gradually add flour mixture to shortening mix in bowl beating until well blended. Stir in oats and chocolate chips.
- 5. Drop by teaspoons onto prepared cookie sheet. Cooked cookies should be about 2 inches or less in diameter.
- 6. Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove from cookie sheet to wire rack or counter top.
- 7. Cool completely before bagging. Makes about 4-1/2 to 5 dozen cookies.

She made her decision and prayed for Him to come into her heart forever. Praise the Lord!
