We also made a decision that was extremely difficult one for the board and the community. We had to cancel a Men's GRACE Emmaus Unfortunately, this is a direct reflection on our GRACE community. We had twelve men who wanted to engage the Lord Jesus on this meaningful weekend. There was a team of willing workers assembled who adjusted their personal lives to provide the arms, legs, head, and heart for Jesus to the pilgrims. 
